EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Molding Moral Males (M3) is a faith-based mentoring enrichment program for male youth located in Central Ohio. Focusing on mental, physical, and spiritual health, this program aims to lay a lifelong foundation for its participants. This program is devised to change its participant's mindset which in turn will produce confident, competent, and productive males.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

M3, founded by William and FannieMae West, is an outreach ministry of the Chosen to Live Outreach Ministries, a **501(c)(3)** nonprofit organization headquartered in Reynoldsburg, Ohio. The program's aims are to organize, encourage, unite, enable, and inspire a whole community to liberate young males through spiritual identification, character building, and the furtherance of ethics and morals. M3 emphasizes family well-being and values and has identified positive male role models as mentors for molding children outside of the home and combines classroom instruction and speakers with supervised field trips and live interaction and demonstration of the male experience.

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M3 CURRICULA

M3 utilizes male program staff and non-program male mentors to help build character and positive life skills for program participants. M3 is designed to build resilience, identify positive character traits needed for success, and help students work toward developing those traits. All programs/camps are administered from a community church and/or academic environment. The program meets once weekly during school and during the summer in our eleven week Summer Enrichment Program—on the following topic schedule:
